Position: Livestock Manager/ Assistant Livestock Judging Coach **Status:** (full time, exempt)
Reports to the Farm Manager

Job Overview: Livestock Manager is responsible for all aspects of the farm including all livestock supervision, operating farm equipment, facilities, requisitions, and student workers. The CSC Farm is an educational facility with the primary purpose of supporting the academic functions of the Division of Agriculture. This position will require assisting the Livestock Judging Coach in workouts, reasons sessions, and recruiting.

The omission of specific statements of duties does not exclude them from the position if the work is similar, related, or a logical assignment to the position

Duties and Responsibilities

- The position will be split 70/30(70% Farm and 30% Livestock Judging)
- Livestock Manager is responsible for all livestock supervision and farm utilization.
- Assist the Livestock Coach in all livestock judging activities, after farm duties are met.
- Must be able to represent Connors State College in a professional manner at all times.
- Must supervise student labor.
- Should efficiently coordinate daily chores and activities on the farm.
- Will work under the supervision of the Director of Farm Operations in establishing goals and practices to ensure progress of the CSC Farm.
- Maintain an accurate record system for all livestock operations including purchase orders and livestock inventory.
- Must be willing and able to perform necessary manual tasks.
- Keep facilities and grounds clean and in a manner that is presentable to the public.
- Perform the duties necessary for a successful college farm operation and livestock team without time and weekend constraints.
- Assist in all course labs when the farm and/or animals are used.
- Provide reports and records if requested by the Director of Farm Operations.

Qualifications

- Associate in Science Degree required in Agriculture or related field, Bachelors Degree preferred.
- Collegiate Livestock Judging Experience required.
- Ability to Artificially Inseminate- swine and cattle.
- Ability to work well with a diverse population.
- General Knowledge and Experience in animal agriculture and pasture management.
- Must be able to bend, stoop, and lift up to 75 lbs.
