Agriculture	Open to all agriculture majors with full-time status & 2.5 GPA. Further details to be announced.
Alumni & Friends	Open to all students maintain full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
Barnie J. Cheek	Open to incoming freshmen majoring in a agricultural field. Maintain 2.75 GPA & full-time status. Preference given to Sequoyah county resident, work-study, student, & based on financial need & achievements. If student quits working for the college, he/she will not be awarded the scholarship the following semester. Student must reapply each fall semester to continue the scholarship.
Bert O. & Gloria A. Baker January Entry	Open to January - entry Nursing students accepted to the Nursing Program. Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA.
Bert O. & Gloria A. Baker	Open to Nursing students accepted to the Nursing Program to be awarded during the student's second academic year. Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA.
Baker Nursing	Open to Nursing students accepted to the Nursing Program. Student must maintain a 2.5 GPA.
Dr. Carl O. Westbrook	Open to all students maintaining full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
E.P. & Roberta L. Kirschner	Student must be handicapped as defined: Impaired of vision, hearing, or other sensory functions; limitations to physical movement due to birth defect, accident, injury, or illness; impairment of mental or neural capacity; or a health condition that seriously impedes and /or complicates participation in education experiences. Student must have a 2.5 GPA at entry & must maintain a 2.5 GPA each semester to retain the scholarship.
Kirschner Nursing	Must be a full-time student in the Nursing Program and maintain a 2.5 GPA.
Garner Academic	Open to all Science Major students maintaining full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
General Foundation	Open to all students maintaining full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
Hoyt James Scholarship	Student must be handicapped as defined: Impaired of vision, hearing, or other sensory functions; limitations to physical movement due to birth defect, accident, injury, or illness; impairment of mental or neural capacity; or a health condition that seriously impedes and /or complicates participation in education experiences. Student must have a 2.5 GPA at entry & must maintain a 2.5 GPA each semester to retain the scholarship. Must apply each year. Preference given to Haskell County residents.
J. E. Myers	Open to students entering his/her Sophomore year as an Equine Major maintaining a 2.5 GPA. Final selection is made by the JE Myers Family.
James King Armstrong	Open to Agricultural students maintaining full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
Joe Synar	Open to all students maintaining full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
Miller Family	Open to all students maintaining full-time status & a 2.5 GPA.
Nero Teaching	Recipient must be majoring in Teacher Education. Must maintain 1/2 time status (no less that 6 credit hours per semester) & a 2.5 GPA.
Owen & Velma Taylor	Open to unmarried females, preferably with dependents. (Non-traditional student) Preference is given to Sequoyah County residents. Must have a 2.0 GPA at entry & maintain a 2.0 GPA. Final selection to be made by Mrs. Velma Taylor.
Ray Freedman Business	Open to all students maintaining full-time status and a 2.5 GPA
Tom Wood	Selection is based on unmet needs by other scholarship funds & the recipient must not receive State or Federal Financial Aid or enhanced ACT Scholarship. Primary consideration is given to CSC employees or the child or spouse of a current or retired CSC employee. Recipient must maintain 3.0 GPA. Funds may be used to meet tuition, books, supplies, materials, room & board or other related college expenses & shall be paid directly to Connors State College.
Vera E. Stangle	Open to Freshmen students maintaining a 2.3 GPA. Scholarship funds will be awarded each semester for one academic year (2 semesters) only. The Director of Baptist Student Union will select the most outstanding freshman student at the end of his/her first year & funds will be disbursed following selection.
Young Family	Student must be enrolled as a full-time student at Connors State College. Student must have at least a 2.5 GPA. Student will be selected by a representative (s) of the Young Family.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

The Connors Development Foundation, Inc. (the Foundation) administers a number of private scholarships that are funded and awarded by individuals, foundations, agencies and organizations. The donors set the scholarship requirements and the Connors Development Foundation Scholarship Committee (composed of faculty and/or staff and Foundation Board members) select the recipients with the exception of a few selected by specific departments/boards. Unless otherwise specified, general requirements for most scholarships include maintaining a 2.5 GPA and full-time status to remain eligible for the scholarship. The amount and availability of each scholarship may vary from year-to-year; therefore, the recipient of each scholarship will be notified by award letter of the amount and stipulations. All scholarships are for the academic year and must be notified by award letter of the amount and stipulations. All scholarships are for the academic year and must be applied for yearly. Please refer to criteria for each scholarship listed or contact the Foundation office for further information.

DISBURSEMENT

Scholarship recipients must provide the Foundation a "Thank-You" letter to be forwarded to the donor. Disbursement of the award will not be allowed unless a "Thank-You" letter is received by the Foundation. Scholarship monies will be disbursed through the business office after outstanding fees, if any, are paid.

IMPACT ON FINANCIAL AID

Scholarships are considered "resource" funds under state and federal guidelines; therefore, scholarship awards become part of a student's financial aid package. Scholarships are first used to cover the student's "unmet need". Gift aid (grants) will be reduced only if the total of all awards exceeds the amount of financial aid for which the student is eligible. In no case will the Pell Grant be reduced as a result of a scholarship. Additional documentation pertaining to applicant's income may be requested. If additional income verification is request, it must be provided before the applicant will be considered for an award.
