#### TO DETERMINE PRIORITY STATUS:

- 2 Find the transcript summary that follows the Spring 2013 term. It should look similar to the example below.

- 3 Add the number of EARNED CUM/RET CREDIT HOURS to the number of hours you are attempting in the Spring 2013 semester. In this example, the student has 34 EARNED CREDIT HOURS and is enrolled in 14 hours for the Spring 2013 semester. 34 EARNED CUM GRAD/RET hours plus 14 hours currently being attempted equals 48 credit hours. Assuming there are no Bursar, Financial Aid or Registration Holds, this student is eligible to enroll on March 28-29.
