Through coordinated partnerships with external constituents and the Connors Development Foundation, Connors Cares provides financial and community service assistance to CSC employees and their families.

Connors Cares Fund

The Connors Cares Fund is designated to provide assistance to CSC employees facing significant financial short term hardship. Standard assistance is provided in \$50 or \$100 emergency needs cards, but exceptions can be made on a case by case basis by the Connors Cares Committee.

Employees can donate to the Connors Cares fund through one-time donations or through payroll deduction. For more information, please contact the Connors Development Foundation.

Applications for assistance are available at the Connors Development Foundation Office or readily available on the Employee Resources page of the Connors website. Annual and Lifetime limits exist for each employee. Other restrictions may also apply.

Examples of situation or hardships NOT for Connors Cares consideration:

Personal transportation Legal or court fees Insurance premiums or deductibles

Examples of situation or hardships FOR Connors Cares consideration:

Non-routine medical expense
Serious illness or injury
Fire, flood or natural disaster (not a Qualified Disaster)
Violent crime
Death of employee or eligible dependent
Domestic violence
Military deployment

Unemployment issues with family Temporary Emergency Housing – Extraordinary expenses not covered by insurance Other undue hardship not caused by employee
