OKLAHOMA REGISTRY CERTIFICATE OF ACHIEVEMENT AND STIPEND PROGRAM

WHAT The Oklahoma Registry Certificate of Achievement and Stipend Program. This is a voluntary program funded by Department of Human Services (DHS) Child Care Services.

There are three types of stipends:

- Oklahoma Right Start Infant/Toddler Certificate of Achievement
- Oklahoma Registry Preschool Certificate of Achievement
- Oklahoma Registry School-Age Certificate of Achievement

** You can only receive **one stipend each year**. You can reapply 12 months after the last Stipend Issue Date.*

WHO For providers who work in DHS licensed child care facilities and meet eligibility requirements.

WHY To validate the achievement and expertise of practitioners and serve as a symbol of professional accomplishment. The stipend program is designed to:

- recognize and reward the specialized professional development achievement of providers,
- encourage teachers and directors to obtain additional focused formal professional development to improve the quality of care for children, and
- increase positive outcomes experienced by children.
