30% went to Pell eligible students. 30% of 892,771 is 267,831.30 and it was divided among the Pell students which totaled 679. So $267,831.3/679=394.45$

If they were enrolled in Fall/Spring they got a flat \$400. If they were enrolled in only one term they got a flat \$200.

The rest of the student CARES funds were then divided by the number of students who had balances and a portion was added to their total amount. There were 924 students who had balances and there was only \$22139.70 remaining of CARES student funds so the total applied for balances was only \$23.96
