ELIGIBILITY FOR THE PROGRAM

If you are joining the program from high school, you need to have a GPA of 3.25 or higher and an ACT Composite score of 20 or higher.

If you are a returning Connors State College student, you need to have completed at least 12 hours of college coursework with a cumulative GPA of 3.25

REQUIREMENTS TO GRADUATE WITH HONORS

- Complete three course-embedded Honors projects (at least one outside major)
- Complete Honors Reading Series and Seminar Series with projects
- Public presentation of one project
- Maintain overall 3.25 GPA
