- ➤ Your FAFSA takes a 'snapshot' of your family's financial condition based on the income from 2020. If there was a significant change in your family's income or there were unusual expenses since you filed your FAFSA the school may be able to take these circumstances into account when determining your eligibility for Federal Student Aid.
- ➤ You should only apply for a Professional Judgment when there are circumstances *beyond the control of the family* that significantly affect the family's ability to contribute to the student's educational expenses.
- ➤ Please fill out this form completely and include all requested documentation to support your appeal.

 Please write your name and student ID # on all additional pages and documents submitted.
- ➤ You must have a FAFSA on file with the Financial Aid Office and must have submitted all requested documents in order to process your appeal. To avoid unnecessary delay, submit paperwork altogether and at the same time. If your request is incomplete, it cannot be processed.
- > NOTE: Doing an adjustment to your and/or your parent's income does not guarantee that your award eligibility will change.
