To be taken at the University of Central Oklahoma.....61-62 plus 32 hours of advanced standing

(May be taken at CSC.) This signifies that a UCO course requirement can be met with the equivalent CSC course (found on the UCO website). To take these courses at CSC, students should confirm with their advisors that the course/s will fit into the associate degree without exceeding the requirements. A minimum of 60 hours must be taken at a baccalaureate granting institution. Exceeding 64 credit hours at the community college means the student will be required to take more than the minimum of 124 credit hour total. A minimum of 40 hours of 3/4000 level courses is required for the baccalaureate. Courses from community colleges are 1/2000 level.

Some of the following University Core courses may be taken at CSC.

Specific University Core Requirements remaining depend on courses selected at CSC in General Education.

Total hours remaining at UCO in this major and support courses61-62 plus 32 hours of advanced standing

Students must meet all bachelor degree requirements at UCO to include:

60 hours from a baccalaureate granting institution.

40 hours of upper division coursework (Students who select lower division courses from Area of Focus:

Global Citizenship may need additional hours of 3/4000 level courses to meet upper division requirement.)

30 hours in residence at UCO

15 of the last 30 hours taken in residence at UCO

124 minimum hours

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
