JOB TITLE: Meats Judging Team Coach

JOB OVERVIEW: Under the supervision of the Agriculture Division Chair, the Meats Judging Coach will perform all tasks required to lead a competitive Meats Judging Team.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Coach the competitive CSC Meats Judging Team
- Coordinate and implement competitive team travel, and practice/work/chore schedules
- Coordinate and conduct competitive and/or recruitment activities for the division.
- Fundraise for team and/or division benefit
- Assist with divisional events, clubs and teams
- Develop promotional materials including but not limited to flyers and pamphlets
- Oversee program website updates and program's social media
- Provide reports and information as requested
- Develop camps, workshops, or field days for instructors and/or youth groups
- Cultivate and develop relationships with alumni groups, business, industry, community
- Other duties as assigned
